ORDER APPROVING RECEIVER'S FIRST INTERIM REPORT AND REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF FEES, COSTS AND EXPENSES

This matter having come on for Hearing on November 20, 2017, before the Rhode Island Superior Court sitting for Providence County, the Honorable Judge Brian Stern presiding, on the Receiver's First Interim Report and Request for Approval of Fees, Costs and Expenses (the "First Report") by Stephen F. Del Sesto, Esq., Temporary and Permanent Receiver herein, and the Court being satisfied that Notice of said Hearing has been given to all pension holders, interested parties and creditors of the Respondent as set forth in the Affidavit of Notice filed by the Receiver relative to said First Report, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 1. That the First Interim Report of Stephen F. Del Sesto, Esq., in his capacity as Temporary and Permanent Receiver herein, and all acts, doings, and disbursements of said Receiver to date are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified;
- 2. That the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver and the Receiver's Special Counsel during the period of August 18, 2017, through and including October 31, 2017 (the "Invoice Period"), are fair and reasonable;

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3. That the Receiver's First Interim request for fees incurred during the Invoice Period

in the amount of \$102,885.00 and costs and expenses in the amount of \$8,997.08 are all hereby

approved in full. That the Receiver is authorized and directed to pay himself an amount equal to

80% of his approved fees and 100% of his approved costs and expenses from available cash-on-hand

in the Estate. The 20% holdback of approved fees for the Receiver shall be held by the Receiver

until further order of this Court;

4. That the Receiver's First Interim request for fees incurred by the Receiver's Special

Counsel, Wistow Sheehan & Loveley PC ("WSL"), during the Invoice Period in the amount of

\$106,593.75 and costs and expenses in the amount of \$31,031.67 are all hereby approved in full.

That the Receiver is authorized and directed to pay WSL an amount equal to 80% of WSL's

approved fees and 100% of WSL's approved costs and expenses from available cash-on-hand in the

Estate. The 20% holdback of approved fees for WSL shall be held by the Receiver until further order

of this Court;

5. That the Receiver's Bond previously posted in this matter shall remain in place until

ordered cancelled by this Court; and

6. That this matter shall remain open and the Order Appointing Permanent Receiver

entered herein shall remain in full force and effect until further Order of this Court.
