2. That the fees, costs and expenses incurred by the Receiver during the period of November 1, 2019 through and including December 31, 2019 (the "Invoice Period") are fair and reasonable;

3. That the Receiver's Eleventh Interim request for fees incurred during the Invoice Period in the amount of \$ 59,749.50 and costs and expenses in the amount of \$3,041.07 are all hereby approved in full. The Receiver is authorized and directed to pay himself in full from available sources of cash in or held by the Estate;

7. The effective date of this Order shall be *nunc pro tunc* as of January 29, 2020.


